



PhD program „Oral Sciences“ at the Dental School of the LMU

The PhD program „Oral Sciences“ is an academic and educative course for promoting research activities on oral health related issues especially for young scientists who are planning a career at a university or dental research centre. The program is open to students of any nationality and appropriate background (medical degrees, biology, chemistry, physics) and life scientists (dentists, physicians, health professionals, biologists, microbiologists, chemist's, pharmacists etc.) sharing our interest and involvement in oral health related research. The PhD program does, therefore, not imply any restrictions on personal interests, age or nationality. The participation in the PhD program is free of charge. In order to apply, the following minimum requirements must be met:

- Successfully completed medical school degree, or university bachelor and master, or adequate equivalent at the time of application
- Proficient knowledge of English language (TOEFL, IELTS, Cambridge)
- Sufficient funding, as the program does not offer any financial support

The PhD program is an interdisciplinary approach of all dental specialities and research groups at the Munich Dental School.

Check list for applicants

The application deadline is January 31st each year. Upon this closing date the selection board will evaluate all applications and notify the applicants about the decisions. Notifications will be delivered around June. We also encourage you to visit the dental school at the LMU in advance.

Only **online applications** will be accepted! Documents sent by email or by postal service cannot be considered anymore. We strongly recommend preparing your application carefully in advance. In case of any missing information it is possible to upload these data until the final deadline. Incomplete applications will be rejected.

During the online application you will be asked to provide the following information or documents (pdf or jpeg format only). All documents have to be in English or German language or an official transcript into either of them languages must be provided. Documents larger than 5MB cannot be submitted due to technical reasons.

- Curriculum Vitae
- Proof of English language proficiency (TOEFL, IELTS, High school or university degree with English as indicated principal teaching language)
- High school certificate
- Transcript of the high school certificate (if not in English or German)
- Bachelor university degree certificate
- Transcript of the bachelor university degree certificate (if not in English or German)
- Final university degree certificate, e.g. Dental School, Medical School, or equivalent
- Transcript of the final university degree certificate (if not in English or German)
- Summary of own scientific experiences which should also include possible areas of oral health interests (maximum of 2500 characters)
- Statement regarding financial support (scholarship, funding etc.)
- A list of previously made publications including own peer-reviewed scientific papers, oral presentations and poster presentations
